Flexible biothane basket muzzles
Hard plastic or wire basket muzzles
Enclosed muzzles
Slip-on soft-sided muzzles
(grooming muzzles)
Muzzles for flat-faced breeds

- Bite prevention

#### **MUZZLE FITTING**

Should not ride up into the dog's eyes or cut tight into the base of the neck

- Basket muzzles should leave enough room to pant, drink water and take food
- Always check sizing with manufacturer guidelines or ask a dog trainer



## MUZZLES SHOULD NOT BE USED

- X In place of training
- **✗** To stop dog from barking
- X For long periods of time

## TIPS FOR MUZZLE TRAINING

- Keep training sessions short (max. 3 min)
- Make it a game and fun for your dog
- √ Work at your dog's pace
- Make wearing a muzzle a regular activity and not only when required
- Work with an AnimalKind trainer to make it a positive experience for you and your dog
